		202. ELIGIBILITY OF NONRESIDENT STUDENTS
1.	Purpose SC 1807, 1841	The Joint Operating Committee operates the SUN Area Technical Institute for the benefit of students who are residents in one of the participating school districts.
2.	Authority SC 1809, 1847, 1850.1	The Joint Operating Committee may admit nonresident students from outside the attendance areas of participating districts if space warrants such admission and an appropriate program can be provided.
	SC 1809, 1847, 1850.1	Nonresident students may be admitted upon payment of annually established tuition rates.
		The Joint Operating Committee shall not be responsible for the transportation to or from school of any student residing outside the center's attendance area.
3.	Delegation of Responsibility	The Administrative Director or designee shall develop procedures for the enrollment of nonresident students which:
		1. Admit nonresident students only on the proper application of the Board of the district where the student resides.
		2. Deny admission where the educational facilities or program maintained for the students of the attendance area is inadequate to meet the needs of the applicant.
		3. Do not exclude any eligible student on the basis of race, creed, color, gender, sexual orientation, national origin, ancestry, or handicap/disability.
		4. Make continued enrollment of any non-resident student contingent upon maintaining good standards of citizenship and discipline.
		5. Makes a condition of acceptance the attendance of the student in accordance with the calendar and the schedule of SUN Area Technical Institute.
		The Administrative Director shall recommend to the Joint Operating Committee for their approval the admission of qualified applicants.
