	223. USE OF MOTOR VEHICLES
1. Purpose	The Joint Operating Committee regards the use of motor vehicles for travel to and from school by students as an assumption of responsibility by parents and students.
2. Authority	<p>The Joint Operating Committee shall permit the use of motor vehicles by students in accordance with center rules, provided that such students are licensed drivers, have parental permission when they are minors, have been granted permission by the principal/supervisor to drive a motor vehicle on center grounds, and have purchased a parking sticker.</p> <p>The Joint Operating Committee shall not be responsible for motor vehicles that are lost, stolen, or damaged.</p>
3. Delegation of Responsibility	<p>The Administrative Director or designee shall develop rules and regulations for operating and parking of motor vehicles and shall disseminate those rules to affected students.</p> <p>The Administrative Director or designee shall establish standards for granting permits, which contain the warning that infraction of rules may result in revocation of the permit.</p>
4. Guidelines	<p><u>Driving Violations</u></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. First Violation - Driving permit suspended for two (2) weeks. Driving suspension means students ride the bus. There will be no riding private transportation. 2. Second Violation - Driving permit suspended for four (4) weeks and assigned to Career Enhancement. 3. Third Violation - Driving permit suspended for the remainder of the school year and parents/guardians will be notified.
