The SUN Area Technical Institute Joint Operating Committee, at their regular meeting held May 18, 2023, acted on the following items:

Heard from Administrative Director, David Bacher:

- ✓ NOCTI scores show 69% advanced and 23% competent for a 92% pass rate. These scores do not include NIMS, which is expected to increase the pass rate.
- ✓ End of Year activities are underway, including the Co-op BBQ this evening, student extended Skills USA meetings held today. On Tuesday, May 23rd, the in Program Awards will be held in the morning, followed by the extended lunch picnic in the afternoon. Wednesday morning will be Certificate Awards practice, and the Certificate Awards Program will begin at 6:30 p.m. Wednesday, May 24th.
- ✓ Two applications for the Advertising Art & Design instructor position have been received, several applications for the SUN Tech Police Chief have been received, applications for the instructional aide position have also been received. We have not received any applications for the Cafeteria position.
- ✓ A meeting was held with the New Berlin Police Chief concerning the SUN Tech Police Chief position.
- ✓ The Cosmetology program has been planting and mulching around the grounds in preparation for the Certificate Awards Program; the Wood, Design & Technology program created a large Class of 2023 sign to be used for a photo prop for the Certificate Awards Program, which has been offered to the districts for their use as well.
- ✓ The Cooperative Education program, to wrap up the year, showed 62 employers, 83 student employees, almost 12,000 hours and \$143,562.00 earned.
